Dear Parent and Student,

Destination Dance is entering its sixth year of providing superior dance training. As always we will continue to focus on each student's growth technically and artistically. In order to maintain the high standards of the studio and proper development as a dancer, two Ballet classes per week for Beginner Intermediate and above are required. It is not necessary to meet the Ballet requirement if you plan on just taking Tap, Hip Hop, Pilates, Acro or Xtend. In order to participate in Jazz, Lyrical or Modern Dance classes the student must be enrolled in the appropriate level Ballet class which will be determined by the instructor.

After successfully establishing a dance training program, I am are pleased to announce I am adding an important component of the dance world to our curriculum – Pilates. The goal is to balance the body by enhancing strengths and improving weaknesses. This will help increase flexibility, strength, coordination, and endurance. **This is not only available for dancers although it will help facilitate their progression more rapidly.** The program sessions include all of the apparatus/equipment and mat exercises appropriate for each individual's needs. The Pilates Mat class is required for the Lyrical, Modern Dance and Advanced Ballet classes. Discounts start when 4 or more classes are taken per week: 4 classes 10% off each month and 5 classes or more get 15% off each month.

Although Destination Dance is not a "Competition School". I do however recognize the importance of a dancer being exposed to other professionals in the field although it will help dancers progress even more quickly.

**Classes commence Tuesday, September 6th. Registration will be held on Tuesday August 30th, Wednesday August 31st and the 1st of September from 5-7P.M. Or by appointment. It is imperative that everyone observe registration hours or make an appointment. I will no longer allow walk ins who are not registered. This keeps everyone back and my classes cannot start on time. No exceptions.** Class size is limited; registration prior to the start of classes will ensure your child's place in the class. Registration also ensures that students are prepared as some classes have uniforms or other required class attire. Registration Fee and first month tuition are due at the time of registration. Pointe shoes may NOT be purchased until approval is given.

I am looking forward to another wonderful year of Dance with you and your child.
